REGISTRATION

LODGING

You must make your own hotel reservations at the Marriott Manhattan Beach (1400 Parkview Avenue, Manhattan Beach, CA 90266) prior to *March 28, 2014*, to receive the CCA negotiated rate. The CCA negotiated room rate with the Marriott Manhattan Beach is:

\$110.00 (plus applicable taxes) per night for single or double occupancy

Please make your own hotel reservations via <u>online</u> or call **(800) 228-9290** (reference "Community College Association-CTA" in order to receive the CCA negotiated rate).

To guarantee a room, you must supply a valid credit card number. Delegate lodging expenses will be reimbursed by CCA according to its Bylaws. CCA will pay one-half the cost of a double-occupancy room. Each delegate is expected to share a room with another delegate. Delegates wishing a single room must pay the difference between a double and single room except in extenuating circumstances. Prior authorization is required. PLEASE NOTE: Delegates Must Attend All Sessions To Be Eligible For Lodging Reimbursement. Delegates are responsible for paying the hotel bill upon checkout.

REMINDER – HOTEL RESERVATIONS MUST BE MADE PRIOR TO MARCH 28, 2014, IN ORDER TO RECEIVE THE CCA NEGOTIATED RATE.

DELEGATES
